

eStore Variations UI Addon

The eStore Variations UI addon allows you to replace the standard "Variations" configuration section in the "Add/Edit" products page with a user-friendly configuration form.

Whereas previously you had to enter specially coded strings (eg, "Color|Green:2|Red:5|Black:7.50") to represent your variations, you can now use this addon to to display a simple userf-friendly form where you can enter the variation details.

Usage Instructions

Pre-requisites

In order for the eStore Variations UI addon to work you will need to have the WP eStore plugin installed and activated.

Configuring Variations for a Product

After installing and activating the addon, you can configure the variations for any product by editing an existing product or adding a new product via the "Add/Edit Products" page.

In the Add/Edit Products page, go to the "Variations" section to configure the variation items for your products as shown in the figure below:

Shipping & Tax (Click to Expand)

To illustrate the user-friendliness of this add-on we have included a couple of before and after examples of some typical variations.

Example 1: Typical Variations

In this example, the user wants to specify variations as follows:

Color: Green (\$2), Red (\$5), Black (\$7.50)

(Where the prices indicated are values which will be added to the base price of the product)

Size: Small, Medium, Large, XL

The original way you would configure the above variations in eStore is shown below:

Example 2: Digital Variations

In this example, the user wants to specify variations for a digital product as follows:

Name of the variation group: License

Variation Names: Single, Business (\$10) and Professional (\$15)

Downloadable Files: downloads/single-license.zip (Single Option), downloads/business-license.zip (Business Option), downloads/pro-license.zip (Professional Option)
